Maintenance Work on State Highway 178 Bridge (Bull Shoals Dam) Requires Lane Closure

MARION COUNTY (10-20) – Maintenance work by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on State Highway 178 requires lane closures, according to ARDOT officials.

Weather permitting; both lanes of State Highway 178 across Bull Shoals Dam will be closed from **8:00 a.m.** through **7:00 p.m.** on **Monday, October 23** and **Tuesday, October 24**. This closure will allow installation of equipment needed to refurbish the tainter gates. During this closure one lane will remain closed from **7:00 p.m.** until **8:00 a.m.** the following morning.

Beginning **Wednesday, October 25** State Highway 178 across Bull Shoals Dam will be reduced to a single lane of traffic until fall 2018. Additional road closures, of up to two days will be scheduled every four to eight weeks to allow for moving equipment as work progresses. Citizens are advised to allow extra time to reach their destinations.

Traffic will be controlled with flagger, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
